How to play:

Each Sunday, from Apr. 3 to Apr. 24, a gameboard will appear in the print edition of the *St. Joseph News-Press*. From that Sunday to the following Saturday, a Flat Joseph or Flat Josephine will appear somewhere in the pages of the *St. Joseph News-Press* near a historic or prominent location in NW Missouri or NE Kansas. Fill out your weekly gameboard by identifying the historic or prominent location the Flat Joe or Flat Josephine (example: Patee House Museum) is visiting each day on the appropriate gameboard location for each day. Box 29, St. Joseph, MO 64502, or by drop it off at the *St. Joseph News-Press* at 825 Edmond St. by the specified date to be entered to win the weekly prizes.

Weekly prizes:
